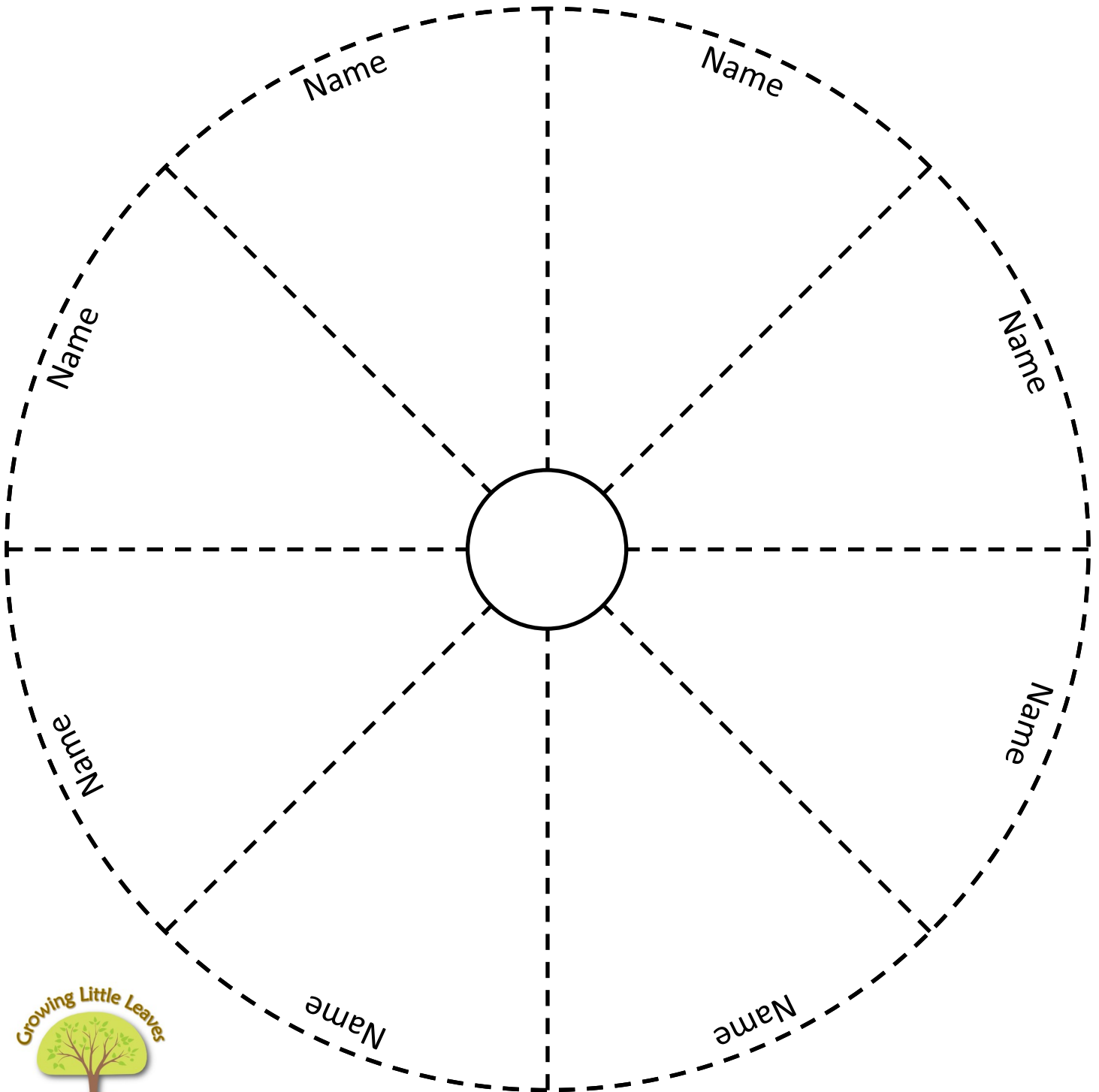


# Great-Grandparent Wheel

## Directions:

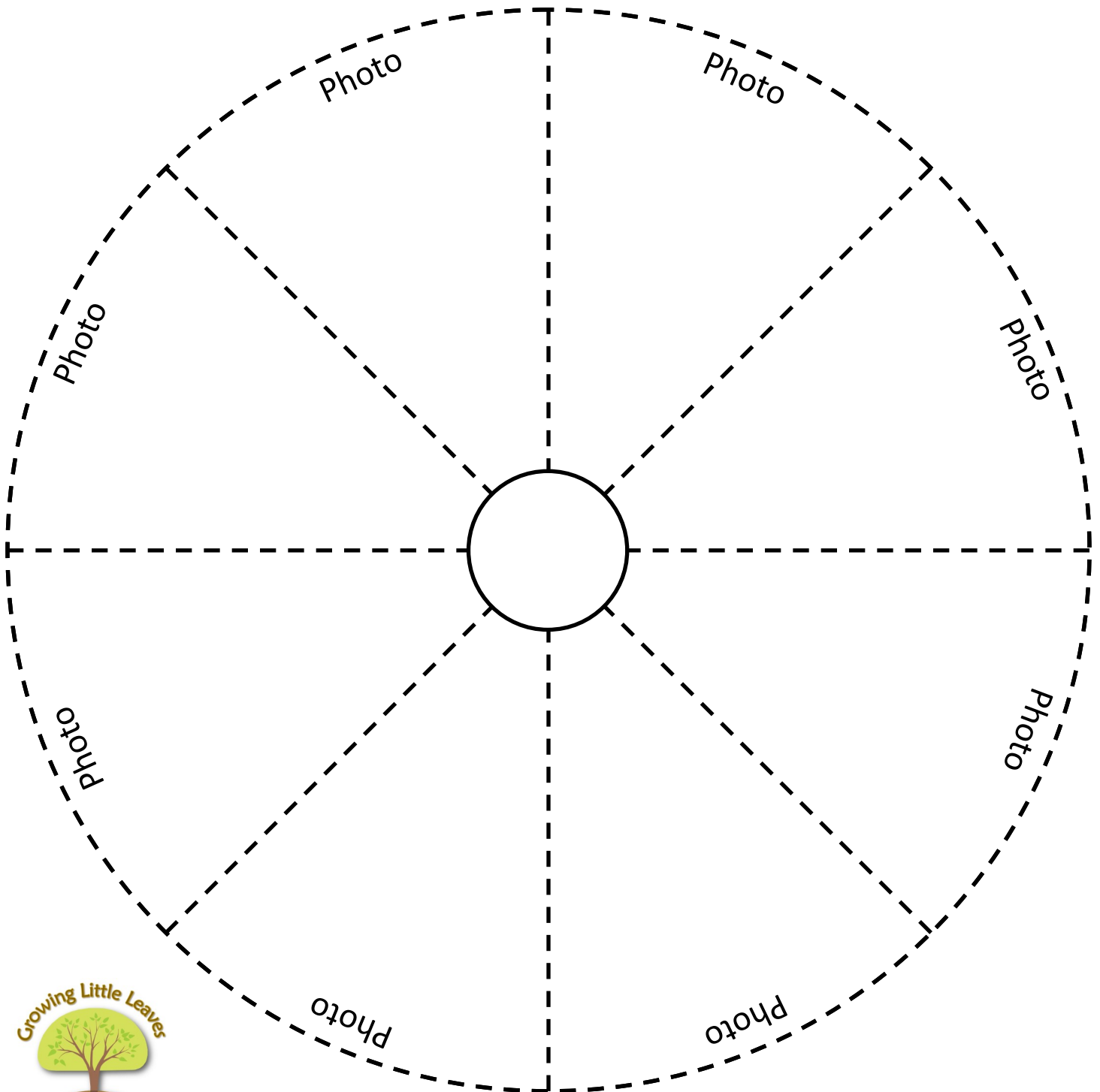
- 1.) Cut out each wheel along the dotted lines. (Do NOT cut the solid lines.)
